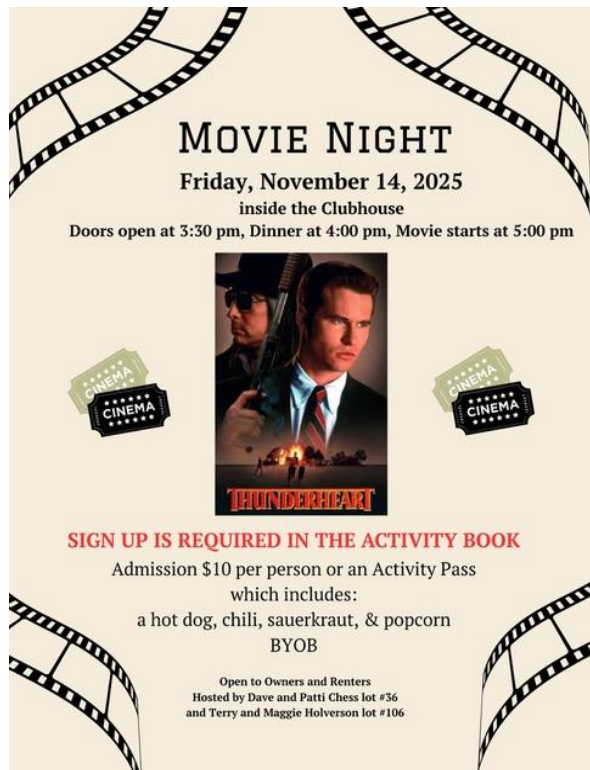

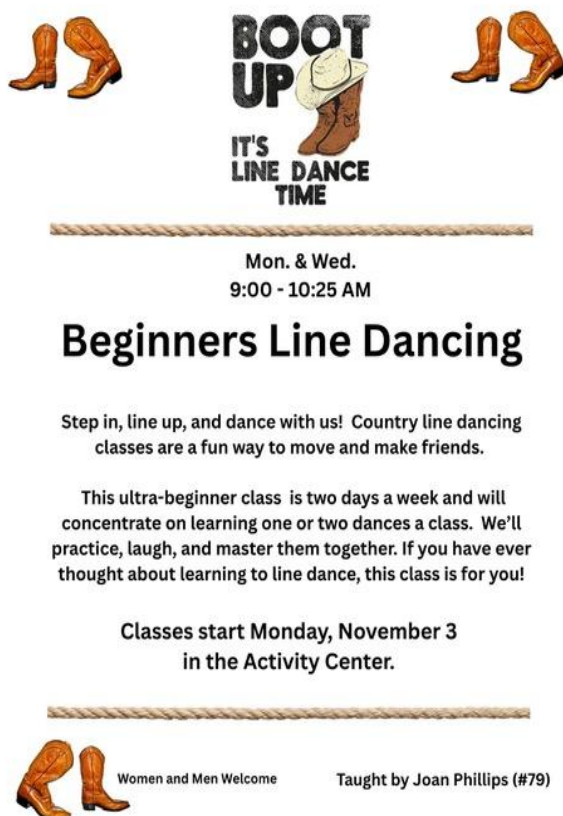

2025-26 SEASON ACTIVITY PASSES

Passes bought after 11/30/2025 will NOT be discounted
Passes are valid from 12/1/2025

\$80 for a couple/per lot
\$40 for a single/per lot
Owners and Renters may purchase passes!

The pass is **NON-TRANSFERRABLE**, meaning only the **NAME(S) ON THE PASS** will be allowed to use the pass.
Passes allow entry to Events that have a ticket cost.

PASS includes:
