Village of Victoria Farms Recap

About 20 people attended the public meeting held by the developer of Victoria Farms Village. We learned the development has new investors and has changed the plan to 300 Manufactured Homes (no RV park), with a Club House and Pool. Current plans show entry and exit on Victoria Farms Way, a short distance from Chenoweth and another entrance and exit above HRVR on Victoria Farms Road. The development has no water supply, so is proposing drilling a well on its property. A traffic study was completed last September. The project is scheduled to be submitted to the City in February. The project will then be reviewed in public hearings by the Planning Commission, then presented to the City Council. If you have any concerns about the project that you feel should be presented during the public hearings, please contact Steve Mindt or Brad Owens or attend the meetings in person to make your voice heard.



First Aid, CPR & AED Training Class
